Action of revitalization on different varieties of cabbages. During the exhibition, the 4,5 m long wood table was the place where to experiment the cycle consumption > revitalization > re-growth of cabbages. The table is divided in three different parts, each one equipped for a specific function: the first part can be used to make food (salad, etc.), the second part is equipped for the revitalization process of the the cabbages wastes (water basin hidden under the table-top, pump, and irrigation system), the third part is the place where to grow the revitalized cabbages till the end of their life cycle (flowering and seed production).
